

## Tying Bench Sili Leg Shrimp--Tied by Alan Sewell

This fly is the best pattern I have ever fished on flats, docks or surf. It is 100 percent weedless. It looks and swims like a shrimp. Tie it with white materials for docklight fishing.


## Materials

Hook: Mustad C71S SS circle streamer hook (2XH/1XL) size 2

Thread: Tan or white

Eyes: Lead or bead chain

- Legs Brown or white "Sili Legs"
- Body Ice Fur, Rusty Orangutan or white. Pearl chenille, rootbeer or white



Hackle Feather, grizzly or white longneck feather

## Tying Sequence



- 1. Attach eyes on top of hook
- 2. Tie on four strands of Sili Legs doubled at rear of hook
- 3. Tie on several strands of flash doubled at rear or hook
- 4. Tie on ice fur and move around the hook shank
- 5. Tie on feather at the tip
- 6. Tie on chenille and palmer it to the front of the eyes. Tie off
- 7. Palmer the feather over the chenille to the front of the eyes.

## Trim excess

- 8. Wrap thread to make a small head
- 9. Glue the head wrap. I prefer Super Glue
