Bruce Evensen: Mylar Mullet



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This is the fly that Bruce was going to teach at the March 16 session but it was canceled because of the corona virus. Thanks to Bill Scarola for tying this fly and providing us with the photo and instructions.



Materials

Hook- 3407 size# 1 or 2, and or stinger same sizes.

Tail- shown - white bucktail, but you can use any colors you wish.

Flash- Flashabou pearl or other colors

Head- palmered Chennile, medium length, pearl and various colors\

Eyes- holographic stick on eyes, medium or 5mm.

Glue- super glue and epoxy

Thread- Flat waxed in white or mono thread

Tying sequence

- 1-Wrap hook from eye to bend
- 2- Add a clump of bucktail about 2/3rds down shaft. 2x hook shank length
- 3-Attach some flash to bucktail
- 4- Cut about 3" of your palmered chenille and tie in behind hook eye.
- 5- Palmer chenille back to just cover the start of the bucktail and flash. Be sure to allow chenille to flow backward to form a tapered head. You can apply some super glue before palmering to hold it securely in place,
- 6- Attach eyes to head. Be sure to keep them above the shank.
- 7- If desired you can UV epoxy the front wrap of chenille.

Note: mixing colors of pattern can complement your chartreuse and white Clousers, deceivers, and other patterns.
